Local Law No. 8 of the year 2024

A local law amending Chapter 63, Article II, section 63-2 of the Code of the Village of Walden, entitled “Deputy Village Manager.”

Section 1. Title

A Local Law amending Chapter 63, Article II, section 63-2 of the Code of the Village of Walden, entitled “Deputy Village Manager.”

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this local law is to clarify the existing language of the Village Code to clearly provide that the decision to fill the position of Deputy Village Manager is discretionary

Section 2. Amendment to Village Code.

The Village Code of the Village of Walden is hereby amended to delete the current Chapter 63, Article II in its entirety and replace it as follows:

Chapter 63. Officers and Employees

ARTICLE II. Deputy Manager

§ 63-2 Deputy Village Manager.

The Village of Walden is authorized to have a Deputy Village Manager whose appointment shall be as prescribed by law. If this position is filled, the Deputy Village Manager shall have such duties as may be assigned by the Village Manager, shall be authorized to act generally for and in place of the Village Manager, and shall perform the duties, assume the responsibilities and possess the powers of the Village Manager during the absence or inability of the Village Manager or during a vacancy in the office of Village Manager. The Deputy Village Manager shall be in the exempt class of the civil service as provided for by law.

Section 3. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 4. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
