AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 179 OF THE WARREN COUNTY CODE (WELLS AND SEPTIC SYSTEMS) TO AMEND THE APPLICATION FEE AMOUNT FOR A VARIANCE APPLICATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that Section 179-12H of the Warren County Code be amended and re-ordained as follows:

Chapter 179. Wells and Septic Systems Article I. Wells and Sewage Disposal Systems §179-12 Variances.

Variances may be granted only as follows:

- A. Variances may be granted if a thorough investigation reveals that the hardship, which may be economic, imposed by this article outweighs the benefits that may be received by the public, provided that the granting of such variance shall not subject any member of the public to unreasonable health risks or jeopardize groundwater resources.
- H. All applications for a variance shall <u>be</u> accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee of \$100 in accordance with the current fee schedule as adopted by <u>the Board of Supervisors</u>.
