INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2023

A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW 3-C FOR THE 2023-2024 FISCAL YEAR

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville, County of Orange, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

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It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Village of Washingtonville, County of Orange, pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 3-c, and to allow the Village of Washingtonville, County of Orange to adopt a Village budget for (a) Village purposes; (b) fire protection districts; and (c) any other special or improvement district governed by the Village board for the fiscal year 2023-2024 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law Section 3-c, which expressly authorizes the Board of Trustees to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2023-2024 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivisions or part of this Local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing of same with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
