VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE

LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF THE YEAR 2023

A LOCAL LAW TO REPEAL AND REPLACE CHAPTER 26, ARTICLE IV OF THE VILLAGE CODE (PROCUREMENT POLICY)

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Washingtonville by authority of Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, as follows:

Section 1. Repeal. The Code of the Village of Washingtonville, Chapter 26, Article IV is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with the local law language set forth in Section 2.

Section 2. Procurement. The following provisions shall be enacted to repeal and replace Article IV of Chapter 26 as set forth in Section 1 above.

§ 26-9 Policy.

- A. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the Village of Washingtonville that with respect to contracts for public work and public purchases, the Village's policy is to assure the prudent and economical use of public moneys for the benefit of all the inhabitants of the Village and to facilitate the acquisition of facilities and commodities of maximum quality at the lowest possible cost.
- B. Where public work and contracts are subject to the provisions of New York State General Municipal Law, Article 5-a (Public Contracts), it shall be the policy of the Village to comply with the applicable provisions of such article.

§ 26-10 Adoption and Review of Village Procurement Policy.

- A. The Village of Washingtonville shall establish and approve a Village Procurement Policy, by resolution, in compliance with the requirements of Article 5-a of the General Municipal Law (Public Contracts).
- B. In addition to compliance with the applicable requirements of General Municipal Law, Article 5-A, such procurement policies and procedures shall, among other things:
- 1. Prescribe a procedure for determining whether a procurement of goods and services is subject to competitive bidding and documenting the basis for any determination that competitive bidding is not required by law;
- 2. Provide that, except for procurements made pursuant to statutory competitive bidding requirements or procurements otherwise exempt from competitive bidding requirements, alternative proposals or quotations for goods and services shall be secured by use of written requests for proposals, written quotations, verbal quotations or any other method of procurement which furthers the purposes of this section and the General Municipal Law;
- 3. Set forth when each such method of procurement will be utilized, taking into

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon being filed with the New York State Secretary of State.
