LOCAL LAW NO. 2023

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE EXPANSION OF RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE VILLAGE EMPLOYEE/OFFICER MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF ETHICS IN THE VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board for the Village of Washingtonville, Orange County, New York ("Village Board") as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

The Village Board of the Village of Washingtonville hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Village to find and appoint qualified people to fill Village offices including the member of the Village' Board of Ethics. The Village Board further finds that the Village law requirement of Village residency for the village employee/officer member ("Village Member") of the Board of Ethics may limit the Village's ability to find qualified or interested persons for such position. Therefore, the Village Board hereby determines that the residency requirement for appointment of a Village Member should be expanded to the boundaries of the County of Orange County, New York.

Accordingly, it is the intent of this Local Law, and in accordance with the State Law, to allow the Village Member of the Board of Ethics to reside outside of the Village of Washingtonville so long as such member resides within the boundaries of the County of Orange, New York.

Section 2. Authority; Supersession of State Law.

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and NYS Village Law § 3-300 and is further intended to supersede New York State Public Officers Law § 3 and any other special law to the extent that such special law may require the Village Member of the Board of Ethics to reside within the Village of Washingtonville.

Section 3. Amendment.

Amendment to Section 14-6(A)(2) of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville shall read as follows:

§ 14-6(A)(2)

Except as otherwise provided herein, all members of the Board of Ethics shall reside within the Village of Washingtonville, New York. A majority of the members shall not otherwise be officers or employees of the village, but at least one member shall be an elected or appointed municipal officer or employee of the Village. The Member that is a municipal officer or employee of the Village may reside anywhere in the County of Orange. However, nothing herein shall be construed to expand any residency requirement

applicable to the title of such municipal officer or employee on the Board of Ethics. Of the initial members, two shall be appointed for three years, two shall be appointed for two years and one shall be appointed for one year. All subsequent appointees shall be appointed to three-year terms.

Section 4. State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5 (26) and (33), this Local Law is classified as a Type II action which requires no further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Section 5. Severability.

If a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Local Law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 6. Code Preparation.

The Village's Code preparation contractor is authorized, without further action of the Village Board, to correct typographical errors, numbering and other related technical changes that do not affect or alter the substantive provisions of this local law.

Section 7. Effective date.

This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
