

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2011

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTERS 21, 48, 88, 150, 175 AND A181 OF THE
CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WASHINGTONVILLE**

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Washingtonville as follows:

Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be referred to as "**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTERS 21, 48, 88, 150, 175 AND A181 OF THE VILLAGE CODE TRANSFERING ALL POWERS, AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VILLAGE PLANNING BOARD TO THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**".

Section 2. Purpose and Legislative Intent

The people of the State of New York have, in the New York State Constitution, Article IX, section 2, delegated the responsibility to local government units to adopt regulations and laws designed to promote the public health, safety and general welfare of its citizenry. The Village of Washingtonville Board of Trustees hereby finds that the transfer of the authority, duties and functions of the Village Planning Board to the Village of Washingtonville Board of Trustees is imperative to further the objectives of the Village's health, safety and welfare and will streamline the oversight and approval process for land development within the Village.

Section 3.

Chapter 21 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout Chapter 21 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 4

Chapter 48 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout Chapter 48 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 5

Chapter 88 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout Chapter 88 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 6

Chapter 150 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout Chapter 150 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 7

Chapter 175 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout Chapter 175 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 8

Chapter A181 of the Village Code of the Village of Washingtonville is hereby amended as follows:

Everywhere the term "Planning Board" is used throughout chapter A181 the same is hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 9

All references to the "Planning Board" not specifically set forth in section 3 through 8 but appear in the Village of Washingtonville Code are hereby deleted and replaced by the term "Village Board of Trustees".

Section 10. Validity

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

Section 11. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws, rules and regulations and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 12. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
