Sections 355-15, 355-16 and 355-17 of the Code of the Borough of Wallington are amended and supplemented to read as follows:

§ 355-15 RATES.

A. Borough's Water Supply Cost.

The Borough has maintained stable rates charged for water supply within eh Borough since 2020.

The main supplier of water to the Borough is Passaic Valley Water Commission which has increased the rates charges to the Borough on 3 occasions since 2020, by

§ 355-17 WATER TURN-ON FEE. A fee of \$10.00 shall be charged for turning on water at the curb stop. The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wallington may increase this rate by resolution of the governing body.

2. All ordinances or parts which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.


