**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON,
WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE IV, SECTION
335-33 (B) PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING VEHICLES AT ALL
TIMES ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF FORREST AVENUE FROM EAST WALNUT
STREET TO CENTRAL AVENUE.**

ORDINANCE 1960 BILL NO. 3 OF 2023

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON,
WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE IV, SECTION
335-33 (B) PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING VEHICLES AT ALL
TIMES ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF FORREST AVENUE FROM EAST WALNUT
STREET TO CENTRAL AVENUE.**

WHEREAS, the codified ordinances of the City of Washington, Article IV, provides for general parking regulations in the City of Washington,

WHEREAS, Section 335-33 of Article IV prohibits the parking of all vehicles at all times in certain locations;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Washington is desirous of prohibiting the parking of all vehicles on the eastern side of Forrest Avenue from East Walnut Street to Central Avenue for the public safety of the residents of the City of Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Washington, it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1: Article IV-General Parking Regulations – Section 335-33 (B) is hereby amended to add the following regulations:

Section 335-33 (B) – parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following location:

Specific Street	Side	Between
Forrest Avenue	Eastern	East Walnut Street to Central Avenue

Section 2: Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3: If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance.
