The Preliminary Plat application to create two new commercial lots has been submitted with a Final Record Plat. The subject site is zoned C-2 General Commercial District. Dollar General Site Plan (SP-172). DG Partners LLC has submitted a Site Plan application for approval for 2.13 acres on the east side of Hwy. 47, north of Isabella Drive. The site plan shows the construction of a one-story 10,640 S.F. Dollar General Store. Appendix A of the Zoning Code shows the retail store as permitted in the C-2 General Commercial District, which the subject site is currently zoned. Planning and Zoning recommended to DENY the Site Plan with a vote of 8 to 0, with 2 absent.

Elizabeth Lum with Amundsen Davis LLC, attorney for the applicant, presented a power point presentation and answered the Boards questions and requested the second reading be tabled till the next meeting.
