

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 140: PERSONNEL OF THE WARSAW MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING TO SECTION 140.170, HEALTH INSURANCE IN LIEU THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Warsaw deems it appropriate to add to the existing section in our Warsaw Municipal Code and the City Personnel Manual:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARSAW, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


- 1. The City of Warsaw hereby adds to Chapter 140: Section 140.170 Health Insurance.
- 2. When a full-time employee reaches the age of 65 and provides proof of converting to Medicare Part A & B as their primary coverage. The city will reimburse the Medicare eligible employee 90% of the monthly Medicare bill and the city will terminated the employee from the city insurance coverage.
- 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended to conform to this Ordinance.
- 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its' approval and passage.


