AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 550: ZONING CODE, THROUGH THE ADDITION OF LANGUAGE TO SECTIONS § 550-53D(1)(b)

SPONSOR: MAYOR MCFARLAND, CHAIR FROM: PLAN COMMISSION WITH POSITIVE RECOMMENDATION

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section § 550-53D(1)(b) is hereby amended as follows:

* * *

- (b) All buildings, structures, outdoor storage areas, and any other activity areas shall be located a minimum of 100 feet from all lot lines. <u>Adjustments to the required 100-foot setback for buildings,</u> <u>structures, outdoor storage areas, or any other activity areas from all property lines may be</u> <u>approved by the Plan Commission through a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) subject to the</u> following:
 - [1] The applicant can demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the Plan Commission, that the proposed setback adjustment will not create undesirable impacts on nearby properties, the environment, or the community as a whole.
 - [2] The use of the property as a salvage yard or junk yard is consistent with the City of Watertown Comprehensive Plan.

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- **SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force the day after its passage and publication.
