8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 157-6 relating to: County Aid Bridges and Culverts.

10 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain*
11 *as follows:*

13 **SECTION 1.** Section 157-6D of the code is amended to read:
14 § 157-6 County Aid Bridges and Culverts.

18 D. Standards. All bridges and culverts receiving aid under this section shall meet the
19 following minimum standards:

21 (1) The minimum size eligible for a County aid culvert shall be a ~~four-foot~~36"
22 or greater span, or a structure of equivalent capacity to carry water. flat bottom culvert or its equal
23 in cross-section area.

25 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon passage
26 by the Board of Supervisors, County Executive and publication as provided by law.

28 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amending the minimum size eligible for a County
29 aid culvert from four feet to 36".
