8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 157-9 relating to: All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility-Terrain
9 Vehicle Routes.

11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain as
12 follows:*

14 **SECTION 1.** Section 157-9 of the code is amended to read:
15 § 157-9 **All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility-Terrain Vehicle Routes.**
16 Purpose. This section is intended to regulate the operation of All-Terrain Vehicles ("ATV") as
17 defined in § 23.33(1)(b), Wis. Stats., and Utility-Terrain Vehicles ("UTV") as defined in
18 § 23.33(1)(ng) under Sections 23.33(8)(b) and (11), Wis. Stats.

20 B. The operation of ATVs or UTVs on any portion of a County highway designated as an
21 ATV and UTV route is authorized:

23 (4) On all County highways located within municipalities that have approved
24 ATV/UTV use.

~~ED.~~ Enforcement. This section shall be enforced in accordance with § 23.33(12), Wis. Stats., including the issuance of a citation under § 66.0113, Wis. Stats.

~~FE.~~ Penalties. Penalties for a violation of this section shall be as set forth in § 23.33(13), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Supervisors, County Executive and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3. SUMMARY. Ordinance designating approved areas for ATV and UTV use on County highways.
