AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OF MGL CHAPTER 40 SECTION 22G AND CREATING A "DISABILITY ACCESS FUND"

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts General Laws authorize cities and towns to allocate all funds received from fines assessed for violation of handicap parking regulations to the commission on disabilities of said city or town; and

WHEREAS, said funds shall be used solely for the benefit of persons with disabilities within said city or town; and

WHEREAS, among said opportunities it is a priority of the Town Council to make Watertown's Town Hall and town services fully accessible to persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, said Disability Access Fund could provide a revenue stream for the modification of Town Hall and town services to effect such access.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the Treasurer of the City known as the Town of Watertown is hereby directed to establish a separate fund of the town, to be known as the "Disability Access Fund", in accordance with the provisions of Section 22G of Chapter 40 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that said access fund shall be used pursuant to said Section 22G, solely for the benefit of persons with disabilities.
