Established under Section 22
of Zoning By-Law

Voted: March 29, 1937

Approved by Atty. General, April 26, 1937

Section 22: APPEALS. Any person aggrieved by the action of the Building Inspector, or by a decision of the Board of Appeals, may appeal under the provisions of Section 30, Chapter 40, of the General Laws.

Upon the adoption of this by-law the Selectmen shall appoint a board of appeals of three members, the first appointments to be for terms of one, two and three years, thereafter for three years. They shall also appoint two associate members, one for a two-year term and one for a three-year term.
