Local Law 5 of 2025

**A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 237-74 OF THE
VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTBURY.**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westbury as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.

To promote safer travel for drivers and pedestrians in the Village, the Board of Trustees finds it advisable to install a new stop sign at the intersection of Carle Road and Woodcock Road. The Board believes this will foster public safety and address the concerns of area residents.

Section 2. Amendment of §237-74 of the Vehicle and Traffic Code.

Section 237-74 is hereby amended as follows:

“In accordance with the provisions of § 237-11, the following described intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections, and stop signs shall be installed as follows:

<u>Stop Sign on</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>At Intersection of</u>
<u>Carle Road</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Woodcock Road”</u>

Section 3. Severability.

If any section or provision of this local law shall be adjudged to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate any other part of this local law, or the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section or provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
