**ORDINANCE NO. 26-11**

**An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic Part 2 Parking Article VIII Metered Time Limit Parking Section 375-37 Violations and Penalties**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic Part 2 Parking Article VIII Metered Time Limit Parking Section 375-375 Violations and Penalties, is hereby amended as follows (deleted sections are noted by strikethroughs, new sections underlined and bold):

Section 1. Amend:

**§ 375-37. Violations and penalties.**

- A. It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of Article VIII of this chapter for any person to:
- (1) Cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or operated by such person to be parked overtime or beyond the period of legal parking time established for any parking meter zone as herein described or to deposit in any parking meter any coin for the purpose of parking beyond the maximum legal parking time for the particular parking meter zone. Fine and penalties not to exceed \$13 \$50 per violation.
  - (2) Permit any vehicle to remain or be placed in any parking space adjacent to any parking meter while said meter is displaying a signal indicating that the vehicle occupying such space has already been parked beyond the period prescribed for such parking space. Fine: \$13, and penalties not to exceed \$50 per violation.
  - (3) Park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking meter space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such lines or markings. Fine: \$13, and penalties not to exceed \$50 per violation.
  - (4) Deface, injure, tamper with or open or willfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meter installed under the provisions of this chapter as the court may fix. Minimum fine: \$250.
  - (5) Deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or metal substance

or other substitute for lawful coins. Fine: \$50.

- (6) Park any vehicle in a manner which encroaches or overhangs any part of a maneuvering space (as defined in Article II, § 375-7). Fine: ~~\$22.~~ **and penalties not to exceed \$50 per violation.**
- (7) Park any vehicle with the front or rear bumper, as appropriate, more than three feet distant, measured parallel to the curb, from the parking meter for said space. Fine: ~~\$13.~~ **and penalties not to exceed \$50 per violation.**
- (8) Obstruct a meter. Fine: \$25 per day per meter. [Added 8-16-2016 by Ord. No. 16-20]

B. Any person violating any provision of this article shall pay the fine listed for such violation.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 4. If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.


