ACTION REQUESTED/ EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: An Ordinance to amend Chapter 168 of Township Code to add regulations prohibiting stopping or standing of vehicles at all times on certain streets. The Office of the Mercer County Engineer and the Township Traffic Sergeant are seeking to prohibit vehicles from stopping or standing along Mercerville-Edinburg Road a.k.a. Old Trenton Road (County Route 535) between Village Road and the Township border with East Windsor Township. The narrow shoulder widths, high traffic volumes, and higher speed limit on this roadway do not support stopping or standing of vehicles. The Township Engineer has reviewed and is in support of this recommendation.

ORDINANCE 2023-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 168, "TRAFFIC AND PARKING," OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST WINDSOR

BE IT ORDAINED, by the West Windsor Township Council, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that the Code of West Windsor Township, be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION I.

CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST WINDSOR, NEW JERSEY

PART II: GENERAL LEGISLATION

CHAPTER 168: TRAFFIC AND PARKING

ARTICLE III: PARKING REGULATIONS, is amended to read as follows:

Section 168-24.1: Stopping or standing prohibited at all times on certain streets.

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule XVII.I (§ 168-72.1) of any day upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule XVII.I attached to and made a part of this chapter.

SECTION II

PART II: GENERAL LEGISLATION

CHAPTER 168: TRAFFIC AND PARKING

ARTICLE VII: Schedules, is amended to read as follows:

Section 168-72.1: Schedule XVII.I: Stopping or standing prohibited at all times on certain streets.

In accordance with the provisions of § 168-24.1, no person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

SECTION III

In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be limited in its effect only to the portion of the Ordinance actually adjudged to be invalid, and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall not be affected.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
