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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, SECTION 8.11 OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE
(FIRE PREVENTION SUBCODE-PERMIT FEES)**

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**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WEST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY** that Chapter 13, Section 8.11 of the Revised General
Ordinances of the Township of West Orange be and are hereby amended as follows:

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to modify the fines set forth in Chapter 13, Section 8.11 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange (the "Township Code") to be amendable by Resolution such that it is amendable in the future by approval of the Township Council, a necessity in an everchanging socioeconomic climate.

**II. CHAPTER 13, SECTION 8.11 SHALL BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED AND
SUPPLEMENTED TO INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING:**

§13-8.11 BE AND HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- The portion entitled "Fire Prevention Subcode-Permit Fees" which specifies the fee in connection with specific categories of inspections and/or permits shall be repealed and replaced by the following language:

In connection with this chapter the following permit fees shall be charged and received:

- a. Acetylene generator, ~~\$25 per year, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution.~~
- b. Ammunition, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.~~
- c. Auto tire rebuilding plant, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 per year.~~
- d. Auto wrecking yards, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$45 per year.~~
- e. Blasting agents, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$45 per year or per trans.~~
- f. Bonfires, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution \$30 each incident~~ except nonprofit.
- g. Bowling establishments, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 each application, \$45 per year in refinishing.~~
- h. Calcium carbide, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.~~
- i. Cellulose nitrate motion picture film, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.~~
- j. Cellulose nitrate plastics, ~~payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.~~

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- k. Combustible fibers, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.
- l. Combustible materials, \$45 per year, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution.
- m. Compressed gases, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- n. Containers for welding and cutting gases, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.

- o. Dipping operations (flammable), payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 per year.
- p. Dry cleaning plants, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- q. Dust producing materials, plant handling, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35.
- r. Explosives, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$75 per month or \$300 per year.
- s. Fireworks display, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$45 each event or \$40 per year storage.
- t. Flammable finishes, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- u. Gasoline filling stations, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$50 for first nozzle per year and \$15 for each additional nozzle per year. Any fee for tank installation shall be separate.
- v. Fruit ripening, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.
- w. Fumigation, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 each application.
- x. Garages, repair, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 per year.
- y. Hazardous chemicals, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$40 per year.
- z. Liquid petroleum gases, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 each installation.
- aa. Lumber yards, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 per year.
- bb. Magnesium, \$30 per year, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution.
- cc. Matches, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.
- dd. Oil burning equipment, to work in conjunction with plumbing, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 each application.

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- ee. Organic coatings, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 each application.
- ff. Commercial ovens, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 each installation, \$10 each item each year.
- gg. Places of assembly, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$20 per year, excludes religious buildings.

- hh. Rubbish fires, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 each incident except nonprofit.

- ii. Spraying operations (flammable payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$35 per year.
- jj. Storing combustible materials, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- kk. Tents, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$20 each installation.
- ll. Thermal insecticidal fogging, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$20 each application.
- mm. Waste material handling plants, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$30 per year.
- nn. Welding and cutting, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- oo. Welding and cutting, tank storage, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$25 per year.
- pp. Welding and cutting, calcium carbide acetylene generator use, payment of a fee in an amount set forth by Resolution, \$20 per year.

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III. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

Any Ordinances of the Township which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

IV. SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

V. **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
