AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, SECTION 7.4 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE (ELECTRICAL SUBCODE FEES)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF

WEST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 13, Section 7.4 of the Revised General

Ordinances of the Township of West Orange be and are hereby amended as follows:

I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this ordinance is to modify the fines set forth in Chapter 13, Section 7.4 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange (the "Township Code") to be amendable by Resolution such that it is amendable in the future by approval of the Township Council, a necessity in an everchanging socioeconomic climate.

II. <u>CHAPTER 13, SECTION 7.4 SHALL BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED TO INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING:</u>

§13-7.4 BE AND HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

• The portion entitled "Electrical Subcode Fees" which specifies the fee for an inspection/permit under Chapter 13, Section 7 of the Township Code shall be repealed and replaced by the following language:

In connection with this subsection the following inspection/permit fees shall be charged:

a. Rough and Final Wiring. (All switches, receptacles, lighting, outlets and fixtures.)

1. One to 25 — \$50.<u>an amount set forth by</u> Resolution.

2. Each additional 25 outlets or fraction thereof — \$12.

b. Swimming Pools.

1. Above-ground — bonding; outlets and motors — an amount set forth by Resolution.

2. In-ground — bonding, outlets and motors — \$100.

c. Periodic Electrical Inspections and "Bonding and Grounding" Certificates for Swimming Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs.

1. The first pool at a site shall be charged <u>an amount</u> set forth by Resolution per pool.<u>\$100 and each</u> additional pool shall be charged \$50.

d. Electrical Signs.
