

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7, TRAFFIC, SUBSECTION 7-46.2,
PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN DAYS ON CERTAIN STREETS
SERVICING RESIDENTIAL LAND USES, EXCEPT BY PERMIT, AND SUBSECTION 7-46.3, PARKING TIME LIMITED
DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN DAYS ON CERTAIN STREETS SERVICING RESIDENTIAL LAND USES,
EXCEPT BY PERMIT OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 7-46.2, Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Days on Certain Streets

Servicing Residential Land Uses, Except by Permit, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is

hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

Section 2. Subsection 7-46.3, Parking Limited During Certain Hours on Certain Days on Certain Streets Servicing Residential Land Uses, Except by Permit, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

Section 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof, under any circumstances, is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any of the provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the valid provision(s) or applications and to this end, the provisions of the Ordinance are severable.

Section 4. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

This Ordinance reflects a change of the daytime permit parking on both Glen Road and Oakridge Road as requested by local residents and the Traffic Division of the West Orange Police. Parking will only be allowed by permit between the hours of

8 AM and 4 PM from Monday to Friday, with permits issued only to residents of the two streets. The permit parking is in place to allow on street parking for the neighborhood residents while prohibiting the overflow parking from Seton Hall Prep from taking all available parking. The two-hour grace period, created for visitors to the neighborhood was taken advantage of by students, requiring multiple trips to the area for enforcement.
