**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, SECTION 11.14 OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WEST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY** that Chapter 25 of the Revised General Ordinances of the
Township of West Orange be and are hereby amended as follows:

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to further clarify the use of Drive-Up windows for public
establishments within the Township.

**II. CHAPTER 5, SECTION 11.14 ENTITLED DRIVE-UP WINDOWS BE AND IS
HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

A drive-up window shall be permitted as an accessory use for banks, restaurants, ~~fast-food
restaurants~~, pharmacies and similar retail uses in the zoning districts in which such uses are
permitted and shall meet the following conditions:

(j) Any restaurant must be situated on property consisting of 5 or more acres and provide ample
queuing to ensure that no waiting vehicles are in or on a public thoroughfare or street.

(k) No Drive-Up windows shall be permitted for any cannabis businesses.

III. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

Any Ordinances of the Township which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby
repealed to the extent of such conflict.

IV. SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the
invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.
