

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, SECTION 1.9 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE (LOCAL ENFORCEMENT OF THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE--PERMIT FEES)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 18, Section 1.9 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange be and are hereby amended as follows:

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to modify the fees set forth in Chapter 18, Section 1.9 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange (the "Township Code") such that the permit fees under Chapter 18, Section 1.9 shall be amendable by Resolution in the future by approval of the Township Council, a necessity in an everchanging socioeconomic climate.

II. CHAPTER 18, SECTION 1.9 SHALL BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED TO INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING:

§18-1.9 BE AND HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- The portion entitled "Permits" which specifies the fee for a permit under Chapter 18, Section 1.9 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange regarding fire prevention and safety shall be repealed and replaced by the following language:

The permit fees established by the Uniform Fire Code shall ~~be amended set forth by Resolution at the approval of the Township Council. to be as follows:~~

Type 1 — \$54 (To also include the use of cooking equipment in a commercial establishment of less than 50 people)

Type 2 — \$214

Type 3 — \$427

Type 4 — \$641

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
