

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7, TRAFFIC, ARTICLE 2 SUBSECTION 7-37.1 REGULATION FOR THE MOVEMENT AND PARKING ON MUNICIPAL AND BOARD OF EDUCATION PROPERTY OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 7-37.1, Regulation for the Movement and Parking of Traffic on Municipal and Board of Education Property, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows: (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

c. No Person shall park a vehicle during the designated hours in the following non-permit or non-metered Municipal Property or Parking Yard:

d. No Person shall park a vehicle when roads are snow covered in the following non-permit or non-metered Municipal Property or Parking Yard:

Section 2. If any provisions of this Ordinance or application thereof, under any circumstances, is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any of the provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the valid provision(s) or application and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

This Ordinance amends Chapter 7-37.1, the Regulation for the Movement and Parking of Traffic on Municipal and Board of Education Property, to add new sections to the ordinance regulating overnight parking by residents in Non-Metered or Non-Permitted Municipal Properties. Additionally, this ordinance will prohibit parking when snow covered to facilitate plowing operations.

Specifically, this amendment targets use of the Township's Dog Park parking lot, but can be tailored for future regulation of additional Municipal Properties.
