

ORDINANCE NO. 1181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO AMEND AND RESTATE THE WEST READING BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 430, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, TO SUPPLEMENT ONE-WAY STREETS AND STOP INTERSECTIONS

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of West Reading, County of Berks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. § 430-11 titled “One-Way Streets”, of Article II titled “Traffic Regulations”, of Chapter 430 titled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Borough of West Reading Code of Ordinances hereby supplements and amends the following list of one-way streets:

- A. In accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. §3308, the following are established as one-way streets, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon a one-way street other than in the direction established for traffic upon that street:

Section 2. § 430-16 titled “Stop Intersections”, of Article II titled “Traffic Regulations”, of Chapter 430 titled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Borough of West Reading Code of Ordinances hereby supplements the list of stop intersections as follows:

- A. The following intersections are established as stop intersections and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street in the direction indicated in each case shall stop the vehicle as required by 75 Pa.C.S.A. §3323(b) and shall not proceed into or across the second named or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

Section 3. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Code of the Borough of West Reading shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

Section 4. If any provision, sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance shall for any reason be found unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not be included herein.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all existing portions of the Code of the Borough of West Reading inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from its enactment as provided by law.
