

ORDINANCE NO. 1183

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION A OF 441-21, TITLED "COMMENCEMENT OF WATER SERVICE", OF ARTICLE II, TITLED "RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS", OF CHAPTER 441, TITLED "WATER", OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE COMMENCEMENT OF WATER SERVICE VIA RESOLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Subsection A, titled "Commencement of Water Service", of Article II titled "Rates, Rules and Regulations", of Chapter 441, titled "Water", of the Borough of West Reading Code of Ordinances is hereby amended in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

§ 441-21 A. Water service shall not be commenced until all existing unpaid water charges against the customer have been paid. The service call charges for commencing and discontinuing water service shall be payable only at West Reading Borough Hall. The fee for commencing and discontinuing water service shall be established by the Borough Council by resolution from time to time.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.

Section 4. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented, and modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, upon adoption.
