

ORDINANCE NO. 1198

AN ORDINANCE OF WEST READING BOROUGH, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 430, TITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF ARTICLE VII, TITLED "OFF-STREET METERED PARKING" OF SECTION 430-60, TITLED "OFF-STREET METERED PARKING LOTS ESTABLISHED" TO ADD A PENN AVENUE MUNICIPAL LOT; SECTION 430-62, TITLED "APPLICABLE DAYS AND HOURS" TO ADD THE ABILITY TO SUSPEND PROVISIONS AND ESTABLISH NO PARKING OR SPECIAL-PURPOSE PARKING ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Subsection A of Section 430-60, titled "Off-street metered parking lots established," of Article VII, titled "Off-Street Metered Parking", of Chapter 430, titled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Borough of West Reading Code of Ordinances hereby amends and supplements to read as follows:

A. The following are established as the off-street metered parking lots operated by the Borough:

Name of Lot	Location
Penn Avenue Shopping Center Lot	515 to 545 Penn Avenue, West Reading, Pennsylvania
Penn Avenue Municipal Lot	433 Penn Avenue, West Reading, Pennsylvania

Section 2. Section 430-62, titled "Applicable days and hours," of Article VII, titled "Off-Street Metered Parking", of Chapter 430, titled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Borough of West Reading Code of Ordinances hereby amends this section to read as follows:

- A. Off-street parking meters shall be operated by payment as prescribed by § 430-66 of this article, and the parking rates for specified lengths of time, to the parking lots listed in § 430-60.
- B. **By resolution, the Borough may temporarily suspend the provisions of this Part.**
- C. **The Borough shall have authority to establish no parking or special-purpose parking zones within any parking meter zone.**

Section 3. All Ordinances of Parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 4. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented, and modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, upon adoption.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
