ORDINANCE NO. 0-23-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE 9-2 (CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY)

IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, the Borough has been experiencing a significant increase in the number

of property owners renting their properties, many for very short terms, and many for

multiple rentals, without having previously sought or obtained a Certificate of Occupancy

or having obtained the same; and

WHEREAS, the current penalty provisions for violating such ordinances make it

more attractive to for the homeowner to violate the ordinance and collect the rent, rather

than comply with the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the code enforcement officials of the Borough, together with members of

the governing body, have requested that the Borough address the current penalty provisions

and increase them in order to attempt to get better compliance with the Borough's

ordinances, and the governing body agrees with the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of

West Long Branch as follows:

**SECTION 1: PENALTIES** 

Ordinance 9-2.13(b) shall be amended to read as follows:

"Any owner who violates this ordinance, or any person who interferes with the

Official or any other person authorized to exercise the powers of this section, shall, upon

conviction in the Municipal Court, pay a penalty of no less than \$1,500 and no more than

\$1,800 for a first offense; and no less than \$1,800, and no more than \$2,000 for a second

or subsequent offense; be subject to a penalty as established in Chapter 1, Section 1-5 of

this code, and such action in and penalties imposed by Municipal Court may be in addition

to any other action or proceeding set forth in this section.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication

according to law.
