AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITPAIN AT PART II [GENERAL LEGISLATION], CHAPTER 142 [VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC], ARTICLE II [TRAFFIC REGULATIONS], SECTION 142-21 [STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED], ARTICLE IV [STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING], SECTION 142-32 [PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS] AND SECTION 142-33 [PARKING, STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITED], TO AMEND CURRENT DIRECTION OF TRAVEL, TO ADD NEW STOP INTERSECTIONS, TO REMOVE CURRENT PARKING PROHIBITIONS AND ADD NEW PARKING PROHIBITIONS IN THE MERCER HILL VILLAGE COMMUNITY

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Whitpain Township Board of Supervisors that the Township's Code is amended as follows:

SECTION 1.

Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic], Article II [Traffic Regulations] Section 142-21 [Stop Intersections Established] to amend direction of travel as follows:

Stop Street	Intersecting or Through Street	Direction of Travel	
Gillin Road	Mercer Hill Road	Northeast	

SECTION 2.

Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic], Article II [Traffic Regulations] Section 142-21 [Stop Intersections Established] to add the following stop intersections:

Stop Street	Intersecting or Through Street	Direction of Travel	
Mercer Hill Road	Gillin Road	Northwest and southeast	
Betsy Lane	Batleson Road	North and south	

SECTION 3.

Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic], Article IV [Stopping, Standing and Parking], Section 142-32 [Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations] to remove the following parking prohibition on Mercer Hill Road

Street	Side	Between
Mercer Hill Road	Both	A point on the center line of Mercer Hill Road 1,709.42 feet north of its intersection with the center line of Morris Road north and west to a point on its center line 80.98 feet west of the center line of its intersection with Gillin Road, being the curve on Mercer Hill Road

SECTION 4.

Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic], Article IV [Stopping, Standing and Parking], Section 142-32 [Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations] to add a new parking prohibition on both sides of Mercer Hill Road

Street	Side	Between
Mercer Hill Road	Both	The center line of Morris Road to a point approximately 125 feet north.
Mercer Hill Road	West	A point 699 feet north of the center line of Morris Road and a point approximately 342 feet north of said point
Mercer Hill Road	East	A point 709 feet north of the center line of Morris Road and a point approximately 358 feet north of said point

SECTION 5.

Amendment to Chapter 142 [Vehicles and Traffic], Article IV [Stopping, Standing and Parking], Section 142-33 [Parking, Stopping or Standing Prohibited] to remove the following parking prohibition on Mercer Hill Road

Street	Side	Between		
Mercer Hill Road	East and West	A distance of 628 feet north of the center line of Morris Road; thence proceeding north through an arc curve for a distance of 691 feet, the total prohibited distance being 1,319 feet. The prohibited area traveling southeast of Mercer Hill Road shall begin at a point on both sides of Mercer Hill Road at a distance of 257 feet southeast of the center line of Betsy Lane		

SECTION 6. Repeal of Ordinance Nos. 47 and 47-1.

Ordinance Nos. 47 and 47-1 adopted by the Whitpain Township Board of Supervisors on July 13, 1964 and October 16, 1989 are hereby specifically repealed in their entirety consistent with Section 3 and Section 5 of this Ordinance and shall be considered null and void.

SECTION 7. Failure to Enforce Not a Waiver.

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION 8. Repeal and Ratification.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the specific terms enacted hereby, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed. Any other terms and provisions of the Township's Code unaffected by this Ordinance are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

SECTION 9. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and affect, and for this reason the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

SECTION 10. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective 5 days after enactment.
