

ORDINANCE NO. 1093

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, COUNTY OF INDIANA, AMENDING
ORDINANCE 911, THE WHITE TOWNSHIP SEWER ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, White Township Ordinance #911, Section 8.02.4, establishes local limits on the amount of various chemicals that may be discharged into the public sewer system; and

WHEREAS, said local limits may from time-to-time be amended, in accordance with directives from Indiana Borough Officials; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Borough Officials have requested a change in the local limits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, County of Indiana as follows:

Section 1: The White Township Sewer Ordinance 911, as amended, shall be amended to revise the local limits set forth in Section 8.02.4, Local Limits, as follows:


Arsenic	0.317 mg/L
Cadmium	0.214 mg/L
Chromium	32.984 mg/L
Copper	5.000 mg/L
Cyanide	4.103 mg/L
Lead	0.781 mg/L
Mercury	0.006 mg/L
Molybdenum	1.814 mg/L
Nickel	6.215 mg/L
Selenium	0.663 mg/L
Silver	7.668 mg/L
Zinc	9.134 mg/L
Ammonia	3151.948 mg/L
BOD	Surcharge


Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its adoption.
