Section 1: Terms of Office Extended

Commencing with the next biennial Town election to be held on November 7, 2023, the terms of office for the position of Town Clerk and Town Highway Superintendent in the Town of Wilton shall be extended from two years to four years.

Section 2: Mandatory Referendum

A proposition to approve Local Law #1 of 2023 was submitted to the voters of the Town of Wilton at the General Election held on November 8, 2022. An Affirmative Statement of the County Board of Canvassers of Saratoga County Board of Elections, dated December 2, 2022 was received December 23, 2022.

Section 3: Effective Date:

This local law shall take effect upon approval of the voters in the general election held on November 8, 2022.

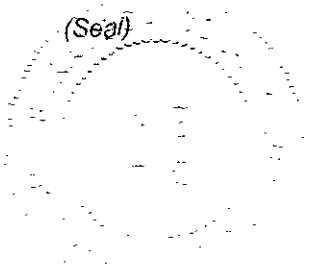
