

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AMENDING CHAPTER 390, TRAFFIC SCHEDULE IX, PARKING RESTRICTIONS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, BY ENACTING NEW PARKING REGULATIONS ON VARIOUS RESIDENTIAL STREETS NEAR LAFAYETTE HIGH SCHOOL; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER TO ERECT APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE REFLECTING SUCH PARKING REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 304.120.2(1), RSMo., “Municipalities, by ordinance, may . . . [m]ake additional rules of the road or traffic regulations to meet their needs and traffic conditions;” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 304.120.2(6), RSMo., “Municipalities, by ordinance, may . . . [r]egulate the parking of vehicles on streets by the installation of parking meters for limiting the time of parking and exacting a fee therefor or by the adoption of any other regulatory method that is reasonable and practical[;]” and

WHEREAS, according to § 300.530, RSMo., “When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described by ordinance[;]” and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri (the “City”), desires to provide improved safety at all times for residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that parking can and should be controlled on Dartmouth Crest Drive, Dartmouth Gate Court, Dartmouth Gate Circle, Westglen Farms Drive, Babler View Drive, Paradise Peak Circle, and Winegarden Court in order to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Chapter 390, Traffic Schedule IX, Parking Restrictions, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wildwood, Parking Restrictions, be and is hereby amended by enacting the following regulations, as set forth in *italics* below:

SCHEDULE IX. PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Part of Street or Road Where Parking is Regulated

<i>Babler View Drive</i>	<i>North side from Mo. Route 109 to Paradise Peak Circle (west)</i>	<i>No Parking</i>
<i>Dartmouth Crest Drive</i>	<i>Both sides from Clayton Road to Dartmouth Place Drive</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Dartmouth Gate Court</i>	<i>Both sides from Dartmouth Crest Drive to 2164 Dartmouth Gate Court</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Dartmouth Gate Circle</i>	<i>Both sides from Dartmouth Crest Drive to end of cul-de-sac</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Westglen Farms Drive</i>	<i>Both sides from Clayton Road to Wood Dale Ridge Court</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Babler View Drive</i>	<i>South side from Mo. Route 109 to Winegarden Court</i> <i>North side from Paradise Peak Circle (West) to Winegarden Court</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Paradise Peak Circle</i>	<i>Both sides from Babler View Drive (west) to Babler View Drive (east)</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>
<i>Winegarden Court</i>	<i>Both sides from Babler View Drive to end of cul-de-sac.</i>	<i>No stopping or standing from 8 AM – 10 AM and from 2:30 PM – 3:30 PM, with the exception of commercial vehicles.</i>

Section Two. The City Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to erect appropriate

signage reflecting the parking regulations enacted pursuant to Section One of this Ordinance.

Section Three. Violations of the restrictions established pursuant to this Ordinance shall be prosecuted pursuant to the Traffic Code of the City of Wildwood and will be controlled and enforced by the St. Louis County Police Department pursuant to its contract with the City, as amended.

Section Four. Savings. Except as expressly set forth herein, nothing contained in this Ordinance shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other Ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in manner connected with the subject matter hereof.


Section Five. Severability. If any term, condition, or provision of this Ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the City Council that it would have enacted this Ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provision, which had been held invalid is no longer invalid, said provision shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the City and shall thereafter be binding.

Section Six. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after the date of its final passage and approval.

This Bill was passed and approved this 8th day of April, 2024, by the Council of the City of Wildwood, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two (2) times prior to passage.
