ORDINANCE NO. 2365

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 510, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WINNECONNE

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Winneconne do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 510-7, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

510-7 Restrictions on parking; posting limitations.

- A. <u>Vehicles defined</u>. <u>Vehicles are defined as</u>, <u>but not limited to</u>, <u>an automobile</u>, <u>truck</u>, <u>van</u>, <u>semi</u> <u>tractor</u>, <u>bus</u>, <u>motor home</u>, <u>pop up camper</u>, <u>travel trailer</u>, <u>trailer</u>, <u>motorcycle</u>, <u>all-terrain vehicle</u>, <u>snowmobile</u>, <u>boat</u>, <u>race car</u>, <u>personal watercraft</u>, <u>tractor</u>, <u>or other motorized or non-motorized</u> <u>device or combination thereof used to transport people</u>, <u>cargo or other vehicles</u>.
- B. Posted limitations. The Village Board shall have the authority to restrict the turning or movement of heavy traffic and to impose special weight limitations on any highway or portions thereof which, because of special or temporary conditions, would likely be seriously damaged or destroyed in the absence of any restrictions on heavy traffic movement or special weight limitations.

(1) The Chief of Police is hereby granted the authority within the reasonable exercise of police power to prohibit, limit the time or otherwise restrict the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles beyond the provisions of Ch. 346, Wis. Stats.

(2) When any law enforcement officer shall find a vehicle, including automobiles, trucks, tractors, trailers, or vehicles of any description standing upon a public street or parking lot for 72 consecutive hours in the same location at any time (except that, where more restrictive parking limitations have been established, the more restrictive limits shall apply), he/she is authorized to move such a vehicle or to require the operator in charge thereof to move such vehicle to a position permitted under this chapter. The law enforcement officer may cause said vehicle to be removed to a proper impoundment and storage area where storage space is available, and in such case the owner shall pay the costs of removing said vehicle and the storage fees on said vehicle before he/she may recover the possession thereof.

- C. Off-street parking in residential areas. In all residential zoning districts, vehicles shall be parked within dedicated parking spaces, such as a driveway or garage and shall be a minimum of 5 feet from any property line or right-of-way line. Vehicles may be less than 5 feet from an interior side property line when screened from view by evergreen plant material or a solid fence approved by the Zoning Administrator and installed between the vehicle and the property line. Vehicles may not be parked or stored within front or street-side yard areas.
- D. Off-street public parking areas. It shall be unlawful to park or leave for storage any equipment or vehicle in any off-street area designated for public parking purposes in excess of 72 hours without written permission from the Winneconne Police Department.

- E. On-street parking of commercial vehicles in residential neighborhoods. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicles, trailers, or equipment used in a commercial or service business overnight on the street within a residential district.
- F. Parking of unattached trailers on the street is prohibited.
- G. Residential vehicle storage. Off-season parking, winterization, and non-use for 30 consecutive days indicate Vehicle storage. Stored vehicles must be owned by the resident occupying the property or owned by the resident's employer. Vehicles may not be stored in front or street side yard areas, in a flood fringe, or a floodway. Stored vehicles must comply with all requirements under the Chapter for parking in a residential zoning districts.
- H. Restricted parking on all Village streets/properties is as follows:

East Side (other than parks/boat launches)

East Main Street/Hwy 116 on the bridge - no parking on bridge West Side (other than parks/boat launch areas)

South Alley from West Main Street rear entrance to 115 West Main Street - no parking in driveway

South Alley from West Main Street rear entrance of 30 South Street - police parking only

South 3rd Street from Taylor Street to the dead end - no parking

North side of Lincoln Street between South 4th Street/South 3rd Street --- no parking West side of North 5th Street from West Main Street to first driveway entry - no parking

South 5th Street between Grant Street/Jefferson Street --- no parking

East side of North 7th Street from West Main Street to Division Street --- no parking North 9th Street/Oak Street - no parking any time

North 9th Street/Willow Street - no parking any time

Enterprise Drive in the turnaround - no truck parking

34 South 2nd Street --- restricted to 10 minute parking and handicapped stall

Parks/Boat Launch Areas

Lake Winneconne Park

Handicapped restricted stalls

Vehicles with boat trailer permit required

Parkway/North 2nd Avenue - no parking on grass

North side of Parkway between North 2nd Avenue/North 3rd Avenue - no parking any time

Parkway between North 3rd Avenue and North 6th Avenue - no parking north side of street

Both sides of North 3rd Avenue and the west side of North 4th Avenue between

Parkway and Riverview two-hour vehicle with trailer parking

Angle parking only north and east side of the park

West side of exit to park from Parkway Drive 50 feet to sign - no parking

Village Boat Launch and Surrounding Area

Vehicle with boat trailer permit required on the following:

Village boat launch parking area

North 1st Street between West Main and Birch Street

South side of Prospect Street between North 1st Street/North 2nd Street

North side of Prospect Street between North 1st Street/North 2nd Street ---- no parking

for vehicles with boat trailers

Handicapped restricted stalls

Marble Park

No parking on grass

Two handicapped restricted stalls

No vehicles on walking trails except Village-owned vehicles

Grant Street parking entrance - no parking beyond parking area

No parking in driveway entrance

Schools

Handicapped restricted stalls

Middle school parking lot - no parking between signs

Middle school parking lot - bicycle only parking

East side of South 3rd Avenue between Pleasant Avenue and Meadow Lane - no parking 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on school days

North side of Meadow Lane between South 3rd Avenue and South 5th Avenue --- no parking 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on school days

West side of South 2nd Avenue from Main Street to Meadow Lane - no parking 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

South side of Pleasant Drive from South 3rd Avenue to first driveway - no parking during school hours
