§ 14-17 Meetings.

- A. All meetings of the Board of Appeals shall be open to the public. The Board of Appeals shall make electronic recordings or keep minutes of its proceedings, recording vote, failure to vote, and absence of each member. The final disposition of appeals shall be recorded by resolution supported by finding of fact and conclusions of law on de novo appeals.
- B. The Board of Appeals shall keep records of its proceedings and official actions. All records of the Board of Appeals shall be public records and shall be immediately filed in the Town office.
