AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC", SECTION 7-39 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOODBRIDGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOODBRIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 7, Section 7-39 Control for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Public and Private Property, Subsection 7-39.1 Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Municipal Property and Board of Education Property is amended to **ADD** the following:

"t. Property: 410 New Brunswick Avenue
(Block 18.02, Lot 3)

Regulations:

1. General parking.
 - (a) No person shall park any vehicle other than within the boundary lines of a parking space. No person shall wash, paint, repair or otherwise work on any vehicle parked in a Municipal Parking Lot provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit necessary emergency repairs to a vehicle.
 - (b) No person shall enter or park in the 410 New Brunswick Avenue Municipal Parking Lot unless such person is:
 - (1) Merchant of the New Brunswick Avenue Business District.
 - (2) Employee of merchant of the New Brunswick Avenue Business District.
 - (3) Shopper of the New Brunswick Avenue Business District.
 - (c) Parking will be limited to a maximum of three (3) hours in all parking spaces between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Exception: The three (3) hour parking time limit will not apply to any person who has applied for and obtained a parking permit from the Woodbridge Police Department. Permits will be available to any merchant of the New Brunswick Avenue Business District.
 - (d) No vehicles shall be parked in this municipal parking facility between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Monday through Sunday (this does not apply to vehicles registered to the Township of Woodbridge.)"


All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

This ordinance shall become effective 20 days after adoption and publication according to law.
