SECOND READING

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF NEW DOVER ROAD AND COLONIA BOULEVARD, WOODBRIDGE TOWNSHIP, MIDDLESEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Municipal Council of Woodbridge Township, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey finds it in the interest of public safety to install a Traffic Signal at the intersection of New Dover Road and Colonia Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer has submitted and certified to all legislative requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4 and N.J.A.C. 16:27;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Municipal Council of the Township of Woodbridge, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section I. The intersection of New Dover Road and Colonia Boulevard shall be controlled by a Traffic Signal in accordance with the As-Built Traffic Signal Plan dated December 1, 2023 and the As-Built Timing Directive dated December 1, 2023.

Section II. That the Traffic Signal shall be in accordance with the provisions of the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Title 39 of the Revised Statutes and the New Jersey Administrative Code and shall be operated in conformance with the designated plan.

Section III. That all prior ordinances and resolutions or portions thereof of the Township of Woodbridge inconsistent herewith be hereby repealed.

Section IV. That this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as required by law.

Section V. That if any clause, section or provision of this ordinance is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
