AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC", SECTION 7-39 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOODBRIDGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOODBRIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 7, Section 7-39 Control for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Public and Private Property, Subsection 7-39.1 Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Municipal Property and Board of Education Property is amended as follows to read:

"s. Property: 10 Main Street, Woodbridge - Modera

Regulations:

- 1. General parking.
 - (a) No person shall park any vehicle other than within the boundary lines of a parking space. No person shall wash, paint, repair or otherwise work on any vehicle parked in a Municipal Parking Lot (lower level parking deck only); provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit necessary emergency repairs to a vehicle.
 - (b) No person shall enter or park in the 10 Main Street Woodbridge Municipal Lot unless such person is:
 - (1) A shopper of the Main Street Business District
 - (2) An employee/staff of merchants of the Main Street Business District
 - (3) Merchant of the Main Street Business District
 - (4) Visitor of Parker Press Park
 - (c) No vehicles shall be parked in this municipal parking facility between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday (this does not apply to vehicles registered to the Township of Woodbridge).
 - (d) Parking will be limited to a maximum of four (4) hours in all parking spaces between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Sunday through Saturday (this does not apply to vehicles registered to the Township of Woodbridge."

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

This ordinance shall become effective 20 days after adoption and publication according to law.
