

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 182 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH TO ESTABLISH RESTRICTED PARKING ON
KINGS HIGHWAY (COUNTY ROUTE 551)
ACROSS THE FRONTAGE OF BLOCK 18, LOT 4.03**

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WOOLWICH AS FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, Section 182-16 of the Code of the Township of Woolwich designates “No Parking” zones on certain streets within the Township of Woolwich; and

WHEREAS, the Woolwich Township Joint Land Use Board approved an application filed by Fair Share Housing Development, Inc. (“FSHD”) for preliminary and final site plan approval and minor subdivision approval for an affordable housing community on a parcel of property fronting on Kings Highway (County Route 551) and designated as block 18, lot 4.03 on the municipal tax map, to be subdivided into proposed lots 4.04 and 4.05; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the proposed development, FSHD also applied for subdivision and site plan approvals from the Gloucester County Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, in connection with FSHD’s application, the Gloucester County Planning Board has issued a Report of Action dated May 21, 2024 (attached) requiring FSHD to “secure an ordinance from the Township of Woolwich that prohibits parking on Kings Highway (County Route 551) across the Subdivision frontage”; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Woolwich supports the prohibition of parking on Kings Highway across the frontage of block 18, lot 4.03.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Township Committee of the Township of Woolwich hereby amends Section 182-16 to enact parking restrictions as follows:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT

Section 182-16 of the Woolwich Township Code is hereby amended to include a “No Parking” zone on Kings Highway (CR 551) across the entire frontage of the property known as block 18, lot 4.03 (to be known as lot 4.05) within the Township of Woolwich

SECTION II. INCONSISTENCY

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption and publication as provided by law.




