Town of Woodstock

Proposed Local Law No. 2 of the year 2022

A local law amending Chapter 260 Zoning Law of the Town of Woodstock, Ulster County, New York adding an additional permitted use in the LI district.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Woodstock as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSES

This Local Law is enacted to permit a public library the LI (light industrial) district.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY

This Local Law is enacted in accordance with Article XIII of Chapter 260 of the Woodstock Code, the Zoning Law of the Town of Woodstock, as amended, Articles 9 and 16 of the Town Law of the State of New York which grants the Town of Woodstock the authority to enact local laws for the purpose of promoting the land use and zoning of the Town, and in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law, Article 2, Section 10, that gives the Town of Woodstock the power to protect and enhance its physical environment.

SECTION 3. ZONING AMENDMENTS

Chapter 260, Zoning Law is hereby amended as follows:

Amend existing § 260-123 to add these definitions:

PUBLIC LIBRARY

Nonprofit library, other than professional, technical or public school, library, established for free public purposes by official action of a municipality or district or the legislature, maintained for public use, usually supported in whole or in part by local taxation, and where the whole interests belong to the public.

LIBRARY

A place in which literary, musical, artistic, or reference materials (such as books, manuscripts, recordings, or films) are kept for use but not for sale, and can include reference and circulating libraries and reading rooms.
