

**BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY
ORDINANCE 2019-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ENTITLED
ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT, OF THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Chapter 4 of the Code of the Borough of Wrightstown is hereby amended as set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 2: Add new Section 4-23, Grant Advisor:

- A. Position created. There is hereby created the position of Grant Advisor for the Borough of Wrightstown.
- B. Appointment and Term of Office. The Grant Advisor shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown. The Grant Advisor shall serve a term of office of one year commencing on January 1 of the year of appointment and ending on December 31 of the year of appointment, or until a successor shall be appointed and qualified.
- C. The Grant Advisor shall be responsible for researching grant programs, assisting the Borough Council in identifying grant priorities, writing grant applications, assisting others with grant applications, working with Council and the Borough Engineer to ensure compliance with grant requirements, submitting reports, submitting invoices, maintaining grant files and supporting audits of grants for the Borough of Wrightstown.

Section 3: All sections of Chapter 4 unaffected by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Severability. If any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or if by legislative action any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall lose its force and effect, such judgment or action shall not affect, impair or void the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

Section 6: Repealer. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

NOTICE

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown held on March 27, 2019. It will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing at the regular meeting to be held at 6:30 PM on April 10, 2019 at the Borough Hall, 21 Saylor's Pond Road, Wrightstown, New Jersey, at which time and place any persons desiring to be heard upon the same will be given an opportunity to be heard.
