ORDINANCE #2008

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 177 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), ARTICLE XII (SCHEDULES), SECTION 177-51 (SCHEDULE S: SPEED LIMITS) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 177 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article XII (Schedules), Section 177-51 (Schedule S: Speed Limits) of the Code of the Township of Wyckoff be amended and supplemented as follows:

CHAPTER 177. VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

ARTICLE XII. SCHEDULES

§ 177-51. Schedule S: Speed Limits.

Name of Street	Speed Limit (mph)	Location
Clinton Avenue Zone 1	30 25	From Lawlins Road to the center of Wyckoff Avenue Entire length
Clinton Avenue Zone 2	30	From the center of Wyckoff Avenue to Main Street
Eder Avenue	30 25	Entire length
Grandview Avenue Zone 1	35 25	Entire length
Grandview Avenue Zone 2	25	Between Wyckoff Avenue and Ravine Avenue when flashing school speed limit signs are in operation and children are going to or leaving Coolidge School during opening or closing hours. At all other times, speed limit is 35 mph.
Hillcrest Avenue	30 25	Entire length
Lawlins Road	30 25	Entire length
Newtown Road	30 25	Entire length

SECTION 2. If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence, or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
