**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE COUNCIL RULES ON RECORDING AND
VIDEOTAPING OF PUBLIC MEETINGS**

Resolved, by the Yeadon Borough Council that:

Members of the public may record or videotape all portions of Council's public meeting provided that their actions do not disturb, disrupt, interrupt, or create a public safety hazard.

All recording must be done from the seating of the member of the public and must not obstruct the view of others in the seating area. The use of a tripod, stand, stool, table, or any other such tool to hold the recording and/or videotaping device shall not be allowed.

All persons wishing to record the public meeting must publicly announce to the Secretary their intent prior to the commencement of the meeting.
