

ORDINANCE NO. 1-30-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YORKTOWN, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 3 BUILDING REGULATIONS, ARTICLE 3.03 ELECTRICITY, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YORKTOWN, TEXAS; ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE 2017 EDITION; ADOPTING LOCAL AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Yorktown (hereinafter “City”) is a Type A General Law municipality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, including Texas Local Government Code section 51.001, the City Council has the authority to adopt, publish, amend or repeal an ordinance that is for the good government, peace or order of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion and finds that adoption of the *National Electric Code* 2017 Edition and local amendments to said *National Electric Code* will promote the public health, safety, and general welfare, and will promote the best and most orderly development of the properties affected thereby, and to be affected thereby, in the City, and as well, the owners and occupants thereof, and the City generally;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Yorktown, Texas that:

I. AMENDMENTS

Chapter 3 Building Regulations, Article 3.03 Electricity, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Yorktown, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3.03 NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE

Sec. 3.03.001 Adopted

A certain document, one copy of which is on file in the office of the city secretary, being marked and designated as the *National Electric Code* 2017 edition, and any amendments that become an official part of said code, as published by NFPA 70, be and is hereby adopted as the building code of the City, for regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use and the demolition of such structures as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said building code on file in the office of the City are hereby referred to, adopted, and

made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions and charges, if any, prescribed in section 3.03.002 of this article.

Sec. 3.03.002 Amendments

Anywhere that the *National Electric Code* references a “permit” or “electrical permit” shall be changed to “building permit-e”.

Sec. 3.03.003 Payment of permit fees

A building permit-e shall not be issued until the fees which are on file in the city secretary’s office have been paid. No amendment to a building permit-e shall be approved until the additional fee, if any, due to an increase in the estimated cost of the installation, shall have been paid.

Sec. 3.03.004 Failure to obtain permit

If any person commences any work for which a building permit-e is required before obtaining the necessary permit from the City, he shall be subject to the penalty prescribed in section 1.01.009.

Sec. 3.03.005 Article Control

The requirements of this article shall control should they conflict with the *National Electric Code* as adopted by the City.

II. REPEALER

All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Yorktown in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Yorktown, not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect. The repeal of any ordinance or part of ordinances effectuated by the enactment of this Ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue, or as affecting any rights of the municipality under any section or provisions of any ordinance at the time of passage of this Ordinance.


III. SEVERABILITY

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
