#### **Town of Lunenburg**

#### **Boating Bylaws**

**Rule 1:** No person shall operate a motor-driven boat on any lake, pond or river in the Town of Lunenburg in such a manner as to endanger the lives and safety of others or the property of others or in such a manner as to create excessive wash or wake so as to interfere with the operation and safety of other watercraft, endanger bathers or damage property.

**Rule 2:** No person shall operate a motor-driven boat on any lake, pond or river in the Town of Lunenburg within 150 feet of a public bathing beach except when making an emergency landing or for life-saving purposes.

**Rule 3:** No person shall operate a motor-driven boat on any lake or pond or river in the Town of Lunenburg while under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

**Rule 4:** No person shall operate a motor-driven boat while towing water skiers, aquaplanes, or similar devices, unless there is present, in said boat, at least one other person capable of observing and assisting the person or device being towed. The person operating a motor-driven boat while engaged in such a towing operation shall be responsible for the safety of such operation.

**Rule 5:** The foregoing rules and regulations shall be enforced by authorized police officials; and the violation of said rules and regulations shall, for each offense, be punished by a fine of not more than \$20.
