Schedule B Annual Service Requirements for Members of Ridgefield Park Fire Department

A qualified year of volunteer emergency service in the Ridgefield Park Fire Department shall be credited under LOSAP for each service year after establishment of the program in which an active volunteer accumulates at least 100 points. Points shall be granted in accordance with the following system:

1. Emergency calls (includes general, zone, still and special alarms) — One point per alarm.
2. Drills (includes company and departmental) — Two points per drill; 12 points minimum, 24 points maximum. Includes participation in seminars, special drills and in-house drills.
3. Training – Two points per hour for attendance at formal fire training classes, CPR classes or any other training classes submitted for approval; 50 points maximum.
4. Elected or appointed office — Points shall be awarded for completion of one full year in an elected or appointed office according to the following schedule, with a maximum of 65 points for any given year:

Chief Officer	50
Company Line Officer	35
Department Executive Officer	35
Company Executive Officer	25
Company Mechanic	25
Department Trustee	20
Company Trustee	20
Departmental Committee Member	15
Company Life Member	50
LOSAP Account Secretary	25

5. Meetings — Two points for attendance at regular monthly meetings and special meetings; 18 points minimum, 30 points maximum.
6. Miscellaneous activities — A maximum of 10 points may be earned annually for participation in the following activities. Each activity shall be awarded two points.
 - a. Wakes and memorial services.
 - b. Weather-related standbys.
 - c. Overnight standbys.

- e. Fund-raising activities.
- f. Parades.
- g. Village events.
- h. Special events.
