#### **Schedule C Annual Service Requirements for Members of Ridgefield Park Rescue Squad**

A qualified year of volunteer emergency service in the Ridgefield Park Rescue Squad shall be credited under LOSAP for each service year after establishment of the program in which an active volunteer accumulates at least 100 points. Points shall be granted in accordance with the following system:

1. Emergency calls — Two points per call.
2. Drills — Three points per drill; 24 points minimum.
3. Duty — One point per duty attended (or approved makeup); nine points minimum.
4. Training — Two points per hour for approved formal training classes; maximum of 50 points.
5. Elected or appointed office — Points will be awarded upon completion of one full-year term in office according to the following schedule (55 points maximum):

6. Meetings — Two points per attendance at regular monthly meetings and special meetings; 16 points minimum.
7. Standby (for disaster or weather-related emergency) — One point for minimum four-hour stays; one additional point for each subsequent eight-hour period; maximum 20 points.

8. Miscellaneous activities — A maximum of 15 points may be earned annually for participation in the following activities. Each activity shall be awarded two points.
  - a. Wakes and memorial services.
  - b. Parades.
  - c. Work details.
  - d. Village event stand-by (4th of July fireworks, tree lighting, etc.).
  - e. Fund-raising.
  - f. Special events.
