PERMITTED STREET TREES

WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP EAC RECOMMENDED NATIVE
STREET TREE SPECIES

TREES GREATER THAN 40 FEET AT MATURITY

Chestnut – *Castanea dentata* (Not Horsechestnut) – use blight resistant hybrid (60-80 feet at maturity)

Black Maple – *Acer nigrum* (50-60 feet at maturity)

Red Maple – *Acer rubrum*

Silver Maple – *Acer saccharinum*

Sugar Maple – *Acer saccharum*

River Birch – *Betula nigra* (60-80 feet at maturity)

Northern Hackberry – *Celtis occidentalis* (20-70 feet at maturity)

White Ash – *Fraxinus americana* (70-80 feet at maturity)

Green Ash – *Fraxinus pennsylvanica* (60-70 feet at maturity)

Sweet Gum – *Liquidambar styraciflua* (50-120 feet at maturity)

Tuliptree – *Liriodendron tulipifera* (50-100 feet at maturity)

Shingle Oak – *Quercus imbricaria* (50-66 feet at maturity)

Pin Oak – *Quercus palustris* (70-80 feet at maturity)

Willow Oak – *Quercus phellos* (55-75 feet at maturity)

White Oak – *Quercus alba* (60-80 feet at maturity)

Black Oak – *Quercus veluntina* (70-80 feet at maturity)

Northern Red Oak – *Quercus rubra* (70-80 feet at maturity)

American Lindern – *Tilia americana* (50-70 feet at maturity)

American Elm – *Ulmus americana hybrid* (70-90 feet at maturity) use dutch elm disease resistant hybrid

Eastern Sycamore – *Platanus occidentalis* (50-130 feet at maturity)

LOW GROWING TREES LESS THAN 40 FEET AT MATURITY

Service Berry – (Tree Form)

American Hornbeam – *Carpinus caroliniana* (20-35 feet at maturity)

Chokecherry – *Prunus virginiana* (10-30 feet at maturity)

Eastern Redbud – *Cercis canadensis* (20-40 feet at maturity)

Quaking Aspen – *Populus tremuloides* (20-50 feet at maturity)

Pussy Willow – *Salix discolor* (30 feet at maturity)

WHITEHALL CODE

Hawthorn – *Crataegus species*

American Hophornbeam – *Ostrya virginiana* tree form (30-40 feet at maturity)

Sassafras – *Sassafras albidum* (10-50 feet at maturity)

Flowering Dogwood – *Comus florida* (10-40 feet at maturity)

EVERGREENS

White Pine – *Pinus strobus* (80-110 feet at maturity)

Pitch Pine – *Pinus rigida* (40-60 feet at maturity)

Virginia (scrub) Pine – *Pinus virginiana* (30-40 feet at maturity)

Balsam Fir – *Abies balsamea* (40-60 feet at maturity)

Eastern Hemlock – *Tsugacanadenis* (60-70 feet at maturity)

Eastern Redcedar – *Juniperus virginiana* (40-50 feet at maturity)

American Holly – *Lliex opaca* (10-40 feet at maturity)

Mountain Laurel – *Kalmia latifolia*

Great Rhododendron – *Rhododendron maximum*

UNDESIRABLE STREET STREETS

Certain trees are susceptible to disease or insect problems, brittle wood, a tendency to heave pavement, undesirable fruit and other objectionable qualities; for these reasons the following trees are not permitted as street trees:

American Elm – *Ulmus americana*

Apple – *Malus pumila*

Birch – *Betula species*

Black Locust – *Robinia pseudoacacia*

Black Walnut – *Juglans nigra*

Box Elder – *Acer negundo*

Coniferous Order – *Coniferates Ord. (needled evergreens)*

European Mountain Ash – *Sobus*

Fruit Trees

Ginkgo (female) – *Ginkgo bilob (female)*

Hopa, Eley & Almey Crabapple – *Malus Hopa, Eley & Almey*

Mulberry – *Morus species*

Osage orange – *Macluna pomifera*

Poplar, Aspen – *Populus species*

Russian Olive – *Eleagnus species*

Silk Tree or Mimosa – *Albizia julibrissin*

Silver Maple – *Acer saccharinum*

Thorned Honey Locust – *Gleditsia triacanthos (Thornless/podless varieties allowed)*

Tree of Heaven – *Tilanthus altissima*

Willows – *Salix species*
