ORDINANCE NO. 282

INTRODUCED BY Alderman Kersch

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ON BOTH SIDES OF MADGE AVENUE BETWEEN THE EAST LINE OF LAY ROAD AND THE WEST LINE OF NORTH AND SOUTH ROAD, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR SAID CONSTRUCTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is necessary to excavate and grade to the established grade and construct sidewalks on both sides of Madge Avenue from the East line of Lay Road to the West line of North and South Road and otherwise improve the parkways from said East line of Lay Road to the West line of North & South Road, on both sides of Madge Avenue in the City of Brentwood, St. Louis County, Missouri, by excavating and grading the same for a width of $11\frac{1}{2}$ feet, measured from the property line toward the center of Madge Avenue and constructing on both sides of Madge Avenue a 4-foot concrete sidewalk.

Section 2. The excavating and grading the parkways and constructing sidewalks shall be done at the expense of the owners of property abutting upon said Madge Avenue, between the points named, because in the opinion and judgment of the Board of Aldermen the general revenue fund of the City is not in a condition to warrant an expenditure therefrom for that purpose and said excavating and grading the parkways shall be included in the same contract as the other improvement of said street and the whole cost thereof levied as a special assessment or tax against the property abutting upon said improvement in the name of the contractor doing the work. Said work shall be done and tax bills issued therefor under Ordinance No. 48A adopted and approved on

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to advertise in a weekly newspaper of general circulation in St. Louis County, Missouri, there being no newspaper published in the City of Brentwood, to all persons interested therein, for bids for doing the work of improvement of said street between the points named in accordance with Ordinance No. 48A of the City of Brentwood, which bids are to be opened by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen at a time and date specified in said notice, or advertisement, and the Board of Aldermen shall thereafter award the contract for the doing of the work to the lowest and best bidder, provided, however, that the Board of Aldermen reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and approval.
