ORDINANCE NO. 366

AN ORDINANCE CONTRACTING WITH THE CITY OF LADUE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI; TO FURNISH FIRE PROTECTION TO THE CITY OF LADUE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI; SETTING FORTH THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT THEREFOR AND WITH AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Brentwood, St. Louis County, Missouri, be and is hereby authorized and empowered to contract, and does hereby contract with the City of Ladue, St. Louis County, Missouri, to furnish fire protection to the City of Ladue according to the terms, provisions, stipulations and agreements hereinafter set forth; said contract to be under and by virtue of an Act of the Missouri State Legislature approved April 1, 1921, found on Page 401 of the Session Acts of Missouri, 1921; and which contract is in words and figures as follows:

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 1938, by and between the City of Brentwood, St. Louis County, Missouri, and the City of Ladue, St. Louis County, Missouri, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the said Cities are empowered by statute and by ordinance duly enacted in each of said Cities, to enter into this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be performed by the said respective Cities, it is agreed between the said Cities as follows:

That the fire department of the City of Brentwood be and is hereby directed to respond to alarms of fire on special call in any part of the territorial limits of the City of Ladue, and to respond to all alarms

of fire in that portion of the City of Ladue south of a line defined as an extension of Elsworth Drive west to a line formed by a line extended south along Overhill Road to the southern city limits of Ladue.

That in consideration for the above-mentioned service by the City of Brentwood, the City of Ladue shall require the fire department of the City of Ladue by ordinance to respond to alarms of fire on special call in any part of the territorial limits of the City of Brentwood, and to all alarms of fire in that portion of the City of Brentwood, the territory known as York Village and York Village Woodlands.

That the period of this contract shall be for five (5) years from the date of its passage and approval.

That in case of loss or damage to the fire fighting equipment of either of the herein mentioned cities while responding to any fire alarm as herein mentioned, such loss shall be born by the city owning the equipment.

That to better carry out the purpose of this ordinance a direct telephone line shall be maintained between the fire stations of the two cities herein mentioned to be used exclusively for fire calls. That the cost of such telephone shall be divided equally between the two cities herein mentioned, but shall not in any event exceed Twelve and 00/100 (\$12.00) Dollars per year for each city.

That an emergency is hereby declared to exist and that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, and approval by the Mayor and as soon as an ordinance embodying the agreements set forth herein, has been passed and approved by the City of Ladue.
