

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GABAUER

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 4 OF SECTION 122 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF 1943 OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI; PROVIDING FOR THE RATE OF COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO DAY LABORERS EMPLOYED IN THE STREET DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE CURRENT MAINTENANCE OF SAID CODE.

Be It Ordained By The Board Of Aldermen Of The City Of Brentwood, Missouri, As Follows:

Section 1. Subsection 4 of Section 122 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of 1943 of the City of Brentwood, Missouri be and the same is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the following words and figures, to-wit:

"One Dollar Fifteen Cents (\$1.15)"

and adding thereto, in lieu thereof, the following words and figures, to-wit:

"One Dollar Thirty-Five Cents (\$1.35)"

Section 2. The rate of compensation herein provided shall be effective from and after the 9th day of June, 1952.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall cause mimeographed copies hereof to be inserted in each currently maintained volume of said Code immediately preceding page 23 thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ⁱⁿ from and after the date of its passage and approval according to law.
